Page 11, Line 232: Paragraph 3 is amended to read as follows:

"(3) Subsection (e)(2) is amended by striking the number "500" and inserting the number "1,000" in its place.

Rationale

This amendment will reinstate a cultivation center plant count limitation of 1,000 as opposed to the unlimited plant count contained in the committee print.

RE: Legal Sufficiency Determination for Amendment to Bill
21-210, the Medical Marijuana Omnibus Amendment Act

The amendment is legally and technically sufficient for Council consideration.

This amendment reinstates the plant count limit, but increases the plant count limit from 500 to 1000 under D.C. Official Code § 7-1671.06(e)(2).
