


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A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend Chapter 3 of Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code to fund a new community hospital and the construction of anchor retail and grocery stores on the East End of the District of Columbia through unassigned end-of-year surplus in excess of 60 days cash-on-hand.

BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “East End Surplus Allocation Equitable Investment Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2 Section 47-392.02(j-2)(4)(B) of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended to read as follows:

“(B) 50% shall be designated for pay-as-you-go capital projects supported by the East End Medical Center Fund, and subsequent to the sunset of the Fund, for unspecified pay-as-you-go capital projects.”.

1 **Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement**

2 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
3 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
4 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

5 **Sec. 4. Effective date.**

6 The act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by6 the
7 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
8 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
9 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
10 Columbia Register.
