25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
26 act may be cited as the "Farmer's Market Meter Fee Cap Amendment Act of 2017".

27 Sec. 2. The Vending Regulation Act of 2009, effective October 22, 2009 (D.C. Law 18-
28 71; D.C. Code § 37-131.01 *et seq.*), is amended by adding a new section 7a to read as follows:

29 "Sec. 7a. Farmer's markets.

30 "(a) For the purposes of this section, the term "farmer's market" means a food venue
31 comprised of vendors who make, bake, grow, or raise the products they sell or of farmers,
32 producers, and other vendors selling fresh produce, healthy foods, or baked goods.

33 "(b) Notwithstanding any statute or rule to the contrary, any parking meter fees charged
34 to a farmer's market by the District Department of Transportation shall not exceed \$50 per day
35 of operation.

36 “(c) The Mayor, pursuant to Title I of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure
37 Act, approved October 21, 1968 (82 Stat. 1204; D.C. Official Code § 2-501 et seq.), may issue
38 rules to implement the provisions of this act.”.

45 Mayor, action by Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as

47 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
48 Columbia Register.
