29 To repeal Initiative 77 – Minimum Wage Amendment Act of 2018.

31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
32 act may be cited as the “Tipped Wage Workers Fairness Amendment Act of 2018”.

33 Sec. 2. The Initiative No. 77 -- Minimum Wage Amendment Act of 2018, enacted on
34 June 29, 2018 (D.C. Act 22-396), is repealed.

35 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

36 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
37 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
38 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

39 Sec. 4. Effective date.

40 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
41 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as
42 provided in section 602(c)(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
43 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code ' 1-206.02(c)(2)), and publication in the District of
44 Columbia Register.
