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27 A BILL

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31 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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36 To amend the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 to change the legal
37 holiday celebrated on the second Monday in October from Columbus Day to Indigenous
38 Peoples' Day; and to amend sections 25-723 and 28-2701 of the District of Columbia Official
39 Code to do the same.

40 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
41 act may be cited as the "Indigenous Peoples' Day Amendment Act of 2019".

42 Sec. 2. Section 1202(a)(7) of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit
43 Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code §

44 1-612.02(a)(7)) is amended by striking the phrase “Columbus Day” and inserting the phrase
45 “Indigenous Peoples’ Day” in its place.

46 Sec. 3. Section 25-723(c)(1)(B) of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by
47 striking the phrase “Columbus Day” and inserting the phrase “Indigenous Peoples’ Day” in its
48 place.

49 Sec. 4. Section 28-2701 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by striking
50 the phrase “Columbus Day” and inserting the phrase “Indigenous Peoples’ Day” in its place.

51 Sec. 5. Fiscal impact statement.

52 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
53 impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
54 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

55 Sec. 6. Effective date.

56 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
57 Mayor, action by Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
58 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
59 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
60 Columbia Register.
