


18 Councilmember Grosso introduced the following bill, which was referred to the

21 To amend Title 22, Chapter 27 of the District of Columbia Official Code to repeal Subchapter II  
22 "Prostitution Free Zones".

23  
24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
25 act may be cited as the "Repeal of Prostitution Free Zones Amendment Act of 2014".

26 Sec. 2. Effective January 1, 2015, Section 104 of the Omnibus Public Safety Act of 2006,  
27 (D.C. Law 16-306 § 104; D.C. Official Code § 22-2731), is repealed in its entirety.

28 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

29 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact  
30 statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule  
31 Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

32 Sec. 4. Effective date.

33 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
34 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as  
35 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December

1 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(2)), and publication in the District of  
2 Columbia Register.
