A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development Limited Grant-Making Authority Act of 2012 to provide the department authority to issue a grant to Check It Enterprises, to enable acquisition of a facility in historic Anacostia, which will serve as an educational and resource center for at-risk youth.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this Act may be cited as the "Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development Limited Grant Making Authority for Check It Enterprises Amendment Act of 2019".

Sec. 2. Section 2032(d) of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development Limited Grant-Making Authority Act of 2012, effective September 12, 2012 (D.C. Law 19-168; D.C. Official Code § 1-328.04(d)), is amended as follows:

(a) Paragraph (2) is amended by striking the phrase "; and" and inserting a semicolon in its place.

(b) Paragraph (3) is amended by striking the period and inserting the phrase "; and" in its place.

(c) A new paragraph (4) is added to read as follows:

"(4)(A) Funds to Check It Enterprises for the acquisition of the property the organization currently occupies at 1920 Martin Luther King Jr. Ave, S.E., Washington, D.C., 20020, to serve as an educational and resource center for at-risk youth.

35 “(B) For the purpose of this paragraph, the term “Check It Enterprises”
36 means Check It Enterprises, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation based at 1920 Martin Luther
37 King Jr. Ave, S.E.”.

38 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

39 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
40 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
41 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

42 Sec. 4. Effective date.

43 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
44 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
45 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
46 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
47 Columbia Register.
